

Arts and Health 2026 Accessibility Statement

We aim to make Arts and Health an enjoyable and accessible experience for everyone.

Where

The festival is on the beach and promenade next to Revo, Weston-super-Mare.

Most of the festival takes place under a stretch tent on the beach which has wheelchair suitable matting from the Prom into the tent and through the tent. Photos are available in our guide below.

Seating

In our stretch-tent there is a mixture of accessible seating.

Parking

Accessible parking is available at Marine Parade Car Park.

Toilets

2 temporary accessible toilets will be available on the Prom (see map in Access Guide). Please find a member of staff (wearing purple, blue, and pink HiVis) for the toilet code.

There are changing toilet places at the Tropicana, within 200 meters. This is open from 8am until 7pm.

Quiet Space

There will be a Quiet Space at the festival.

Support

There will be a limited number of ear defenders and fidget toys available at the information desk.

For any queries/ assistance needed on the day, talk to our Access Companion who will wear a purple Hi-Viz, or the person at the information desk.
